1. **Requirement.** The Joint Service Sub-Aqua Dive Centre (JSSADC) seeks well motivated personnel to serve as incremental staff based in HMNB Devonport, Plymouth. There is a requirement for additional diving instructors, divers and other general duties staff. Whilst desirable, there is no requirement for individuals to possess diving qualifications as training will be provided. Candidates should be keen to learn Adventurous Training skills in support of sub-aqua training, possess a positive attitude and display a willingness to succeed. All candidates must be physically and medically fit. Opportunities exist across a range of ranks however those more junior individuals who wish to demonstrate their potential and develop their leadership skills would benefit the most from this opportunity.
2. **Background.** JSSADC is the lead centre for sub-aqua AT and has recently moved from Fort Bovisand into the dockyard in Devonport. It delivers the full range of British Sub-Aqua Club (BSAC) courses and also trains and validates the Joint Service Sub-Aqua Diving Supervisor (SADS) qualifications.
3. **Benefits.** Detachments to JSSADC of between 2-18 months will offer a variety of benefits to both the individual and their parent unit/ship, including:
 - a. **Individuals.** Enhanced confidence, the opportunity to obtain AT qualifications and improve instructional ability that will complement their normal career profile when they return to their parent unit.

b. **Parent Units/Ships.** During their detachment, individuals will be required to support the routine delivery of sub-aqua diving activity. At the end of the detachment, the parent unit/ship will receive an individual who is confident, self-assured and will have gained a level of diving and boat handling qualifications.

4. **Nominations.** Parent units/ships are requested to ensure that candidates are physically fit, well motivated and free from any on-going welfare or disciplinary issues. All candidates should be in possession of a valid medical fitness to dive certificate issued by a Service Medical Officer or MOD Civilian Medical Practitioner. The medical standards required for certification for Service Sub-Aqua Diving are defined in BRd 1750A "The Handbook of Naval Medical Standards".
