Introduction

1. The 2016 Joint Services Sub Aqua Diving Safety Conference will be held at HMS Raleigh, Torpoint on 16 March 2016.
2. This annual conference allows sub aqua divers of all 3 services to meet, share experiences and knowledge. Crucially it is also a critical component of the safety system.
3. The conference will have a wide range of speakers and currently it is hoped to have representatives from the Superintendent of Diving/Diving Standards Officer (AT), Joint Service Sub Aqua Diving Centre, and British Sub Aqua Club (BSAC). It is also planned to have a Q&A session with members of the Joint Service Sub Aqua Diving Policy Advisory Committee.
4. A full admin instruction and detailed programme will be distributed nearer the time.

Additional Courses

5. JSSADC are running a selection of short courses in the days before and after the conference. It is hoped that this will allow attendees at the conference to gain increased value from their trip to the westcountry. The following courses will be available:
 - a. Instructor Foundation Course, 14-15 Mar 16.
 - b. Diver Coxswain Assessment, 17 & 18 Mar 16

c. Collective First Aid Training (CFAT), 17-18 Mar 16.

Eligibility

7. The event is open to all military sports divers and civilian members of the single service associations (RNRMSAA, ASADA & RAFSAA).

8. All those wishing to attend are to complete the Booking Form at Annex A by **COP 16 January 2015**.

Accommodation

9. Accommodation will be available in the Le Fanu Sports Lottery accommodation in HMS Raleigh for the evenings of 15 & 16 March, as required. Although basic (4 & 8 man rooms) it is clean, warm and offers the opportunity to get better acquainted with other attendees.

Costs

10. Attendance at the safety conference is classed as on duty. T&S costs will lie with individual units.

11. There will be no cost although HMS Raleigh is a PAYD facility. Individuals will need to meet these costs themselves.

Security

12. HMS Raleigh is a service establishment and all personnel will need to either be in possession of an MoD Identity Card or booked in.

Dress

13. Dress for the conference will be smart casual.
